Installing the Certificates

1. Download the [SecureAuth Certificate Installer for OS X](#) from the SecureAuth Downloads Page
2. Unzip the archive
3. Navigate to the **SecureAuth Certificate Installer** and launch it
4. The welcome screen appears – click **Install** to begin



5. If prompted for authorization for SecureAuth Certificate Installer to make changes, then provide the credentials, and click **OK**
6. When the installation is complete, click the **OK** button to exit the installer
